

What's it Mean, Zero Emissions, Zero Deaths, Zero Tolerance By Bandit, Bob T, Rogue, Buckshot, Joe Smith, David Campbell, Barry Green, Ujjwal Dey, Sam Burns, Mr. Wonderful, Joe Smith & the rest of the Bikernet crew

Hey, This is not funny. I attended a CA Air Resources Board meeting regarding new rule making for motorcycles. Every manufacturer of motorcycles was there including Triump sitting beside me & Kawasaki & Honda behind me. At the last meeting I attended, CARB guys dictated to the crowd. There were no discussions. This time, the mostly obese staff talked about embracing all aspects of the market before making their recommendations in 2020. That's the good news. I won't get into this deep here, but they discussed anti-tampering, competition with the EU & Zero emissions. They talked about moving CA to zero emissions by rebates on electric bikes. They want CA riders to be riding 5 million electric bikes by 2025 by executive order from the nice CA Governor. I'm not sure of the total nu of registered bikes by 2025, but that nu will be close. 2 points: 1 is that word Zero again. They use that word in too other regulatory segments, Zero deaths on the highways & Zero tolerance when it comes to drunk driving or drugs. Zero sounds good from one side of the coin, but the other is ultimate control or Zero Freedom. It also has another nefarious side. Zero means the bureaucracy you fund will never go away & grow until it controls everything in its realm. I intend to fight this & CARB's efforts to mandate motorcycles. I'll keep you posted. The other point I hope to make is that motorcycles represent such a small number in the emissions mix we should be left alone. One of the administrators mentioned 2 areas of emissions they walked away from & I hope to help make motorcycles a third or at least the aftermarket motorcycle industry. But that word Zero doesn't help. I'm just a grubby biker, so am I missing something?

------SARASOTA, FL (WWSB) - Sarasota Cnty Sheriff's office says they have arrested an illegal immigrant, Magdiel Medrano-Bonilla, after he struck a motorcyclist during a road rage incident April 8. During the investigation, detectives say they found Medrano-Bodilla's car stripped of its tag, doors & windows. Detectives say they found messages on Medrano-Bodilla's phone that he was planning to destroy the vehicle to avoid criminal charges. Medrano-Bonilla was born in El Salvador & entered the US through Texas. The Sheriff's office will communicate with Immigration & Customs Enforcement to determine the next steps. "This is another example of people illegally coming into our community to commit crimes." said Sheriff Tom Knight. "We have had this conversation time & time again but the problem doesn't seem to be going away. When individuals come into our community & victimize those who live here, I take it personally. Thankfully though, through our partnership with ICE, we have been able to quickly notify their agency & look forward to them prioritizing this case so Medrano-Bonilla will no longer have an opportunity to commit crimes in Sarasota Cnty." According to deputies, the incident happened at the intersection of Beneva Road & Rivera Drive around 5:00 p.m Sunday. A witness recorded the hit & run incident on his cell phone. Sheriff Knight said that the motorcyclist was also given 2 criminal citations for Reckless Driving & Operating an Unregistered Motor Vehicle.


