

You say you will never forget where you were when you heard the news On Sept 11, 2001. Neither will I. I was on the 110th floor in a smoke filled room with a man who called his wife to say 'Good-Bye.' I held his fingers steady as he dialed. I gave him the peace to say, 'Honey, I am not going to make it, but it is OK...I am ready to go.' I was with his wife when he called as she fed breakfast to their children. I held her up as she tried to understand his words and as she realized he wasn't coming home that night. I was in the stairwell of the 23rd floor when a woman cried out to Me for help. 'I have been knocking on the door of your heart for 50 years!' I said. 'Of course I will show you the way home - only believe in Me now.' I was at the base of the building with the Priest ministering to the injured and devastated souls. I took him home to tend to his Flock in

Heaven. He heard my voice and answered. I was on all 4 of those planes, in every seat, with every prayer. I was with the crew as they were overtaken. I was in the very hearts of the believers there, comforting and assuring them that their faith has saved them. I was in Texas, Virginia, California, Michigan, Afghanistan. I was standing next to you when you heard the terrible news. Did you sense Me? I want you to know that I saw every face. I knew every name - though not all know Me. Some met Me for the first time on the 86th floor. Some sought Me with their last breath. Some couldn't hear Me calling to them through the smoke and flames; 'Come to Me... this way... take my hand.' Some chose, for the final time, to ignore Me. But, I was there. I did not place you in the Tower that day. You may not know why, but I do. However, if you were there in that explosive moment in time, would you have reached for Me? Sept. 11, 2001, was not the end of the journey for you. But someday your journey will end. And I will be there for you as well. Seek Me now while I may be found. Then, at any moment, you know you are 'ready to go.' I will be in the stairwell of your final moments.

DAD'S POEM





A special day & though you cannot meet him, I wanted you to know all about my daddy & how much he loves me so. He loved to tell me stories; He taught me to ride my bike. He surprised me with pink roses, & taught me to fly a kite. We used to share fudge sundaes, & ice cream in a cone.& though you cannot see him, I'm not standing here alone. Cause my daddy's always with me, Even though we are apart I know because he told me, he'll forever be in my heart" With that, her little hand reached up,& lay across her chest, Feeling her own heartbeat beneath her favorite dress. & from somewhere in the crowd of dads her mother stood in tears proudly watching her daughter who was wise beyond her years. For she stood up for the love of a man not in her life, doing what was best for her, doing what was right. & when she dropped her hand back down, staring straight into the crowd. She finished with a voice so soft, but its message clear & loud. "I love my daddy very much; He's my shining star & if he could, he'd be here. But heaven's just too far. 

What do they do to protect the shrub & tree roots in the winter to keep the soil moist & loose? ST. FRANCIS: After throwing away the leaves, they go out & buy something which they call mulch. They haul it home & spread it around in place of the leaves. GOD: & where do they get this mulch? ST. FRANCIS: They cut down trees & grind them up to make the mulch. GOD: Enough! I don't want to think about this anymore. St. Catherine, you're in charge of the arts. What movie have you scheduled for us tonight? ST. CATHERINE: 'Dumb & Dumber', Lord. It's a story about....

GOD: Never mind, I think I just heard the whole story from St. Francis.



You see a school bus traveling toward you on the opposite side of the road. Do You stop when it stops?

In short, you must stop for a school bus that is flashing red lights & has the stop arm extended -- unless (1) you are going the opposite direction, (2) you are on a divided Hwy, & (3) the divided Hwy has either a 5' unpaved space or a physical barrier separating the roadways. If all 3 of the above are present, you should continue driving at a legal speed, but with an increased awareness that school-aged children are in the vicinity. Ah, do you have some questions? Like, what is a barrier? Like, what is an unpaved space? Like, what about paved cross-overs on some divided Hwys? These answers should help you!

A barrier is a continuous permanent or semi-permanent obstruction that makes it very difficult for a vehicle or pedestrian to go from one roadway to another. Examples of a barrier are a chain-link fence or a concrete abutment. Traffic cones or trees in a medium are not barriers. ALSO, PAINTED LINES, PAVEMENT MARKINGS, & 1- OR 2-WAY LEFT-HAND TURN LANES DO NOT CONSTITUTE A BARRIER. An unpaved space is a grass, dirt, gravel, water, etc. division between one- or multi-lane roadways going in opposite directions. This space may either be a swale lower than the roadways or a median raised above the roadways. While "paved" sometimes refers only to concrete surfaces, in this context "paved" refers to any hard surfaced permanent ground cover.

Most divided Hwys with an intervening unpaved space or barrier have paved cross-overs at certain intervals. What do you do if a bus is stopped exactly at that cross-over? It is the general character of the entire road that counts & in this situation you are not required to stop, unless there is a school crossing guard on duty who is signaling you to stop or there is a traffic signal with a red light facing toward your vehicle. The 1 or 2-way left hand turn lanes common between many single-& multi-lane roadways are never to be considered a barrier or "unpaved" space. If you are traveling on one of these roads, you must stop for a school bus that is flashing red lights & has the stop arm extended -- regardless of the direction you are traveling or the number of lanes in either direction. School buses are equipped with yellow flashing lights in addition to red flashing lights. Do I have to stop for a bus that is flashing yellow lights? Flashing yellow lights are for warning purposes, primarily to let you know the driver is nearing a loading or unloading zone & will soon be stopping & displaying flashing red lights & extending the stop arm. You should not stop for flashing yellow lights; however, you should slow & be prepared to come to a complete stop. If otherwise legal & safe to pass, you may pass a school bus in this situation. But again, be aware that there may be school-aged children in the vicinity. Remember, most likely you will not be the only vehicle on the roadway going in the same direction. When you see a school bus with yellow lights flashing, start preparing to stop. Signal your intentions by slowing down & activating your brake lights. Don't surprise the drivers behind you by your actions. You know the law & are a safe driver. Always let the other driver, who may not know the law or may not be as safety conscious as you, know what you are doing.

Amount of penalties (Section 318.18, FS): Left hand pass: 1st offense: \$165 --- 2nd or subsequent offense (within 5 yrs): \$165 plus license suspension for 90 days to 6 months . Right hand pass: 1st offense: \$265 --- 2nd or subsequent offense (within 5 yrs): \$265, license suspension for 180 days to 1 yr, plus a mandatory hearing

LOCAL: EARLY VOTING DRAWS THOUSANDS ON 1ST DAY More than 15,000 Floridians had cast ballots as of Tuesday morning in counties where early voting has started in advance of the Aug. 30 primary elections, according to the FL Division of Elections. The early-voting option, which allows people to fill out ballots at designated polling locations, is mandated statewide from Aug. 20 through Aug. 27. However, county supervisors of elections have the discretion to begin sooner. Twenty-four counties started early voting on Monday. Miami-Dade County had the largest number of early voters as of Tuesday morning, with 2,775. In Duval County 2,444 people had voted early, followed by 1,904 in Hillsborough County. Of the 15,718 early votes cast, 8,024 were from registered Democrats, 6,434 from Republicans, 164 from people with minor party affiliations and 1,096 from people without a party affiliation. In addition to early voting, more than 2.2 million Floridians have requested vote-by-mail ballots for the primary. Of those, 659,532 people had voted as of Tuesday morning, with Republicans outvoting Democrats 318,460 to 252,277.
